Brigadier General E Eser Deputy Chief of Staff Plans

Brigadier General Ersin Eser is the Deputy Chief of Staff Plans at NATO's Headquarters Allied Air Command, Ramstein Air Base, Germany. He is responsible to the Chief of Staff for directing, monitoring and co-operating operational capability development staff functions and developing and implementing policy related to operational issues. He advises the Commander, through the Chief of Staff, on policy matters regarding programming, planning and conducting of military cooperation activities, including Civil-Military Cooperation, tactical assessments and evaluations.

General Eser earned his commission in 1991 as a graduate from the Turkish Air Force Academy. He took the Undergraduate Pilot Training Course at Reese Air Force Base, Lubbock, TX.

After completing F-16 Conversion Training at 4th Main Jet Base, Ankara, General Eser served as an F-16 pilot at several F-16 squadrons, including 162nd Air to Air Squadron, Bandırma, 143rd F-16 Conversion Squadron, Ankara and 151st SEAD Squadron, Merzifon. He is a graduate of the Turkish Air War College and Turkish Armed Forces Staff College.

General Eser commanded 143rd F-16 Conversion Training Squadron in Ankara and 8th Main Jet Base Fighter Group consisting of three squadrons of bomber, air to air and Search and Rescue assets in Diyarbakır. He served as staff officer in J5 Advance Planning Branch for 3 years and as J3 Targeting and Ops Specialist Section Head for 2 years at Joint Force Command Naples. General Eser speaks English and Italian and is married with two children.
